GRANDVIEW HIGH SCHOOL PROFILE 2006-2007

COMMUNITY	The Cherry Creek School District, celebrating over 50 years of excellence, is located in the southeast metro-Denver area. The District boundaries include the cities of Aurora, Centennial, Littleton, Englewood, the incorporated communities of Greenwood Village and Glendale, and a large unincorporated area of Arapahoe County. Cherry Creek School District has a student population of approximately 48,000 students.
GRANDVIEW HIGH SCHOOL	Grandview High School, in its ninth year in the Cherry Creek School District, is a public, comprehensive, suburban, college-oriented high school with a student enrollment of approximately 2800 students in grades nine through twelve. Grandview, one of six high schools in the District, has a calendar of 180 days, comprised of two eighteen week sessions. Grandview utilizes an alternating block schedule, a daily schedule of four, ninety-nine-minute periods. Both the Colorado State Department of Education and the North Central Association of Colleges and Secondary Schools accredit Grandview High School.
ETHNIC PROFILE	The school ethnic profile reflects a student population of 75% Caucasian, 9% African American, 7% Asian, 8% Hispanic, and, 1% Native American. Of these students, 2% are English Language Acquisition (ELA).
FACULTY/STAFF	The Grandview faculty and staff are well-educated and qualified. Six administrators and 240 staff members work with Grandview students and of those, 181 are certified teachers. Six deans, eight counselors, and two school psychologists provide students with support services.
POST GRADUATE	Approximately 75% of graduates will attend four-year colleges/universities and 9% two-year colleges. Of those attending four-year institutions, 71% will attend in-state schools, and 29% will attend out-of-state schools.
